Richard is on the go.... six countries, five missionary units, and three ministry

**projects....** Richard is traveling in Vietnam, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia (yes, finally!), Cambodia and South Korea from Nov. 8-23. The focus is to carry out onsite visits with missionaries/ministries/ministry sponsors (pastoral and administrative), attend various international meetings (Kuala Lumpur, MY) and make accountability visits to check on the progress of a number of ministry projects.



In these trips he seeks to be a blessing to others, but often finds that he is the one who is blessed—it is incredible to see how God is at work in so many places especially in the midst of a troubled world. In Romans 5:1-11 there is an emphasis on justification and salvation—all peoples now have <u>peace</u> with God based upon the sacrifice of the Lord Jesus Christ. In verses 6 thru 10 there is an interesting emphasis: humanity (Jew & Gentile) is **powerless** (vs 6), **ungodly** (vs 6), **sinners** (vs 8) and even described as God's **enemies** (vs 10). Yet, the love of the Triune God is so great that, at just the right time....God demonstrates His own love for us—Christ died for us. This is the message that we and our colleagues proclaim as Interserve personnel and ministry projects unfold among the peoples of Asia and the Arab world.

Two of the missionary families that he will visit are new to their context. It will be good to drop by and walk with them in the places and connect with the people that God has called them to serve. It will provide these new missionaries with a listening ear and a sounding board for the enthusiasm they experience in thriving in God's calling and the challenges that are ever present in cultural and language acquisition.

We seek to live in communities for extended periods of time, learning their languages and adapting to their cultures while letting them experience the difference that the presence of the Lord makes in our lives.
